Remembrance Sunday 2024

Remembrance Sunday has come around again, and it continues to be important that we stop and remember. Towards the end of the service today, we will gather around the war memorial in time for a two-minute silence at 11.00am to help us do just that, stop and remember. Immediately after the service, tea, coffee and refreshments will be served. You would be most welcome to join us!

As we do with everything in the Benefice, we are making an effort to include all ages in our services today. During our act of remembrance the children and young people are encouraged to place a cross at the foot of the war memorial after the other wreaths have been laid. If you have children with you today, they will be given a cross to decorate during the service.

We recognise that for some of you, today is a day that will bring back memories of loved ones lost in times of conflict. We hope that you will find this service an opportunity to reflect and give thanks for them. But we pray too that you will discover throughout this service that we worship a God who understands our grief and is able to empathise with our loss. God gave up his son in the war over death and sin, it took Jesus to the cross as the ultimate sacrifice. But that sacrifice won for us the ultimate victory.

Today we can know our God as we trust in Christ our Lord.

We know God is victorious because Christ now reigns in glory. It's the greatest

news this world can know real peace, everlasting peace - a peace that sets us right with our creator God.
