The very first Christmas carol ??

One of my favourite childhood Christmas memories is going carol singing on Christmas Eve with two or three other families who lived along our road, and at the end, being invited into quite a large posh house for mince pies and drinks. I still love singing Christmas carols, and so this year's Advent devotional book, "Sing in Exultation" is just up my street as each day we are invited to explore through a verse of a carol the Christmas story as told throughout all of Scripture beginning with the Old Testament prophesies and ending with Christ's birth and the hope of His second coming.

This Sunday, as we come to the third Sunday in Advent, I have chosen to look at what might be considered to be the "very first Christmas carol", "The Magnificat", which Mary sang in response to being told that she is to give birth to a child who "will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High". Today, we often sing the well-known hymn "Tell Out my Soul", which captures the words of The Magnificat, and although not traditionally associated with Christmas, is a wonderful Advent hymn as we wait with hope and expectation for the birth of Christ our Saviour.

So, do come to Dale Abbey on Sunday Morning (9am Communion) to both sing this wonderful hymn and learn more about Mary and her response to the visit of the Angel Gabriel.

And don't forget the Carols by Candlelight service at Stanton by Dale at 6-30pm – where you will be able to sing lots of Christmas carols (but won't hear my sermon!!)
